## **A Morning on the Farm @ Blue Moon Acres – June 26th, Ages 5-14, 8:00am – 5:00pm**

We'll travel to Blue Moon Acres Farm located in Debec where we'll have a guided tour and have the chance to meet lots of farm animals, including baby goats! Following our return from the activity, there will be swimming and field house activities. Participants can be picked up at AYR Motor Centre at 5:00pm. 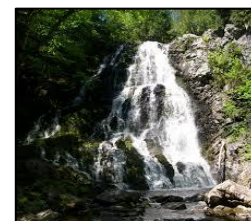


## **Strawberry Picking @ McLellan's Farm – July 3rd, Ages 5-14, 8:00am – 5:00 pm**

### **St. Andrews Aquarium– July 25th, Ages 8+, 8am – 7pm**

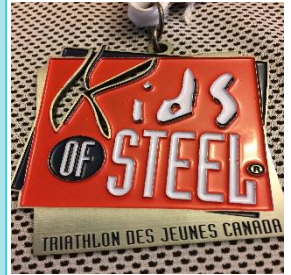




## Summer Special Events

# REGULAR SUMMER PROGRAMS



## **Youth Golf- Mondays, June 24th to July 29th, 10-11:30am, Ages 8+**

Participants will learn the technical skills of the game through use of the course and driving range. Kids will be transported by the Recreation Department to the *Covered Bridge Golf & Country Club* in Hartland. We meet at the AYR Motor Centre at 9:30am return at noon. Participants will get personalized support and individual feedback from Assistant Pro, Wade Lapage. It is recommended that participants have their own equipment. Limited: 16 participants. Cost \$90 includes instruction, transportation to Hartland and lunch at the clubhouse on July 29<sup>th</sup>. Must register in advance. Payment must be made at the time of registration.



**Horseback Riding and Horse Care- Mondays, June 24th to July 29th, 2-4pm, Ages 6-15yrs.** Participants will be transported in the community van to R&R Stables to learn how to care for horses and learn how to ride.
