The Council of the Town of Woodstock, under authority vested in it by Section 96(1) of the Municipalities Act, R.S.N.B., 1973, Chapter M-22, enacts as follows:

Preamble

The purpose of this by-law is to amend by-law #S-1, an Animal Control By-law.

Title

This By-law may be cited as a By-law to amend By-law #S-1, an Animal Control By-law.

(1) By-law #S-1, an Animal Control By-law, enacted on this 24th day of September, 2001, together with all amendments, is herein amended by adding a new sub section 10.(3) as follows:

10. (3) Stoop and Scoop

If an animal defecates on any public or private property other than the property of its owner, the owner or person in control of the dog shall remove such feces immediately. This section shall not apply to persons using seeing-eye dogs.
