A By-law to Amend By-law #81,
A By-Law To Regulate the Fire Department of the Town of Woodstock

Section 1(d) of By-law #81 is hereby amended by adding the following new section in substitution of Section 1(d) of By-law #81:

1. When used herein the words noted hereunder have the following meanings:

(d) “Manager” means the Chief Administrative Officer for the Town of Woodstock

Section 2 of By-law #81 is hereby amended by adding the following new section in substitution of Section 2 of By-law #81:

2. The Fire Department structure shall be staffed in the following manner:

- (a) Council shall appoint a Fire Chief who is the highest-ranking Officer and director of the Fire Department.
- (b) In addition to the Fire Chief, the Fire Department shall consist of a Deputy Fire Chief, two Captains, one Lieutenants, a Training Officer and a Safety Officer as appointed by the Chief Administrative Officer upon the recommendation of the Fire Chief.
- (c) Volunteer Firefighters shall be appointed, as deemed necessary by the Fire Chief to provide Fire Protection Services.

Section 6 (a) of By-law #81 is hereby amended by adding the following new section in substitution of Section 6 (a) of By-law #81:

6. The Council may from time to time by resolution:

- (a) Fix the remuneration to be paid out to all members of the Fire Department, as set out in Schedule ‘A’ of A By-law to Regulate the Fire Department of the Town of Woodstock.
