

## **COVID-19 OPERATIONAL PLAN**



The AYR Motor Centre will continue to follow the Provincial State of Emergency, the Provincial Recovery Plan, and the guidance and direction of the Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health (CMOH) as its recreation facilities are opened during the COVID-19 pandemic.

AYR Motor Staff must be respected at all times, and in regards to the enforcement of the terms and conditions set out within this document. Any abuse or disrespect towards staff, volunteers, other patrons etc. will not be tolerated.

- Up to a maximum of 50 participants will be permitted in the Field House and Gallery Room, on a first come, first serve basis.
- A facemask must be worn in all public areas in the facility, including the lobby, hallways, washrooms, etc. The only exception is during activity in the field house, where social distancing must be maintained.
- \*During the Orange Phase, participants will be asked to wear their face mask at all times, including during activity in the field house.
- Students must Enter the AMC through the front lobby and proceed to the Gallery Room for screening.
- Each person is required to wash their hands or sanitize upon entering the facility.
- Each student will be screened including having their name and contact number recorded. This information will be kept for up to 21 days and made available to Public Health if requested.
- Students will be provided an area to leave backpacks and outdoor footwear.
- Students will not be permitted in the changing rooms. Public washrooms will be available in the lobby area.
- Students will only have access to the Gallery Room, the Field House (designated Courts), and washrooms.
- Students are to Exit through the front lobby.
- A Field House Monitor will be on duty to enforce ALL guidelines.
