NOMINATIONS CRITERION OF WOODSTOCK SPORTS WALL OF FAME

- 1.1 Nominations shall be made on official nomination forms and submitted to the W.S.W. Secretary, and contain the fullest possible data concerning the record and merits of each candidate. Nominations must have the consent of the nominee, or if deceased, the family. Supportive material in the way of newspaper clippings, letters from witness nominee's standard of involvement and etc.
- 1.2 Nominations must be received by the Secretary not later than February 25 of each year.
- 1.3 Not less than ninety days in advance of the deadline for nominations, the W.S.W. shall invite nominations from sport organizations and individuals by means of a media release and paid advertisement in the local media.
- *All nominations submitted if eligible, will be considered for selection in the year nominated and for two succeeding years. If the nominee has not been selected after being considered for three years, the nomination may not be re-submitted for a two year time period, and the nominator will be so advised.
 - If not re-submitted, the nomination will be placed in an inactive file. Any nomination placed in the inactive file may be retrieved for consideration upon the request of a member of the W.S.W.
- Nomination forms and related information shall be available from the Secretary, W.S.W. and the Town Office.
- 1.6 Upon receipt each nomination shall be acknowledged by the Secretary, and checked regarding compliance with eligibility requirements (Section 2.2). Nominations deemed ineligible will upon direction from the nominator be retained on file until the candidate is eligible, or returned to the nominator.

II. ELIGIBILITY FOR SELECTION

- 2.1 Any nominees who by outstanding achievement have attained prominence in those fields of sport, as defined from time to time by the W.S.W. or who have made a major contribution to the development and advancement of sport in Woodstock are eligible for selection.
