The AYR Motor Centre will continue to follow the Provincial State of Emergency, the Provincial Recovery Plan, and the guidance and direction of the Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health (CMOH) as its recreation facilities are opened during the COVID-19 pandemic.

In addition to the requirements set out below, all users/groups must be familiar with, and in compliance with all of the most recent relevant requirements outlined by the Province of New Brunswick.

AYR Motor Staff must be respected at all times, and in regards to the enforcement of the terms and conditions set out within this document. Any abuse or disrespect towards staff, volunteers, other patrons etc. will not be tolerated.

- Each School is required to record the list of names of students/teachers/assistants that are attending each lesson. This information will be made available to the Facility Manager and Public Health, if requested for up to 21 days.
- Each student/teacher/assistant is required to wash their hands or sanitize upon entering the facility.
- A facemask must be worn in all public areas in the facility, including lobby, hallways, washrooms, etc. and where social distancing is not possible.
- Classes will leave their outdoor footwear in the storage boxes provided.
- Classes will arrive with swim attire on and ready to go onto the deck to begin their lesson.
- Students will Enter onto the deck through the side Lobby area.
- Students will be given an area on deck to store their personal belongings.
- A washroom will be available in the Family Changing Room.
- Classes will have access to all three changing rooms after the swim time is over.
- Classes will Exit through the side door off of the Lobby.
- Parents/Guardians are permitted to watch from the deck or mezzanine area and must wear a facemask.
